

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL

5 JULY 2018

The regular meeting of the Winchester City Council was called to order by Mayor Stewart. Council present: DeeDee Morris, Miriam Youngren and Les London. Council absent: Rosemary McLeod

Council person Morris moved to approve minutes of the June 2018 council meeting. Councilperson Youngren seconded. M/C Unanimous.

Councilperson Youngren moved to approve Bills and fund transfers. Councilperson Morris seconded. M/C Unanimous.

Mike Haight, City Maint. Superintendent requested the following items:
Walco will begin installing fence around dumpsters next week.

Jeremy Heft, Fire Chief, reported on fires this year and preparation for Winchester Days Celebration
Fire permits are in effect from June 20th to Sept. 20th each year. And an air quality permit is also required by the Nez Perce Tribe.

Councilperson Morris moved to approve catering permit for KC's Burgers and Brews for Winchester Days
(at Syl's Saloon location) Councilperson London seconded. M/C Unanimous

Councilperson London moved to approve special use permit for summer/4H season. Smith Councilperson Morris seconded. M/C Unanimous.

Councilperson Youngren moved to approve special use permit for summer/4H season Lawson Councilperson London seconded. M/C Unanimous.

Councilperson London moved to approve special use permit for summer/4H season Councilperson Youngren seconded. Council person Morris abstained. M/C

Jason Davis, Lewis County Sheriff, presented the 2019 Law Enforcement Contract. Contract includes a 3% increase (\$279) per year. Sheriff's office is working on getting a repeater installed on the Winchester Water Tower.
Councilperson Morris moved to approve a 3% increase in the Law Enforcement Contract effective FY 19. Councilperson London seconded. M/C Unanimous.

Councilperson Morris moved to reimburse LaVella Reilly \$1,288.32 for a water leak. Councilperson Youngren seconded. London, nay; Morris, aye; Youngren, aye. M/C
(this includes a water/sewer bill and damage clean up.)

Bernadette Stewart, Utility Coordinator reported on legislative issues.
