

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL
4 OCTOBER 2018

The regular meeting of the Winchester City Council was called to order by Council President, Rosemary McLeod. Council present: Rosemary McLeod, Miriam Youngren, DeeDee Morris, Les London.

Council person Morris moved to approve minutes of 6 September Public Hearing. Council person London seconded. M/C Unanimous.

Council person Morris moved to approve minutes of the 6 September regular meeting. Council person London seconded. M/C Unanimous.

Council person McLeod moved to approve a conditional use permit for Kenneth and Joni Cox to extend 6 ft. into the property set back to re-install a porch that had been grandfathered (217 Spalding Ave). Council person Morris seconded. M/C

Building permits submitted: Brammer – porch; Grueter – replace deck; Winchester Bar and Grill – replace/repair back stairway; Lawson – cover deck.

Mayor Youngren stated that comments from guests would be placed back on the Agenda with strict controls.
