MINUTES BUDGET HEARING 7 P.M.

The regular meeting of the Winchester City Council was called to order by Mayor Youngren. Council present: Steve Grover, Les London and John Lawson. Council absent: DeeDee Morris.

Councilperson Lawson moved to approve the minutes as presented. Councilperson Grover seconded. M/C Unanimous.

Council set a special meeting for October 22, 2020 at 6 p.m.to discuss the Wastewater Study Grant Project. Meeting will be held at community center.

Josh Eckert, Inland Cellular, presented a informal proposal to put equipment on the water tower for cell and internet service. He will get us a spec list for equipment.

Airbridge was present to present contract for Internet Service, with equipment on the water tower. Councilperson Lawson moved to approve this contract and Councilperson London seconded. M/C Unanimous.
