

MINUTES OF THE WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL
MEETING
1 OCTOBER 2020

MINUTES BUDGET HEARING 7 P.M.

The regular meeting of the Winchester City Council was called to order by Mayor Youngren. Council present: Steve Grover, Les London and John Lawson. Council absent: DeeDee Morris.

Councilperson Lawson moved to approve the minutes as presented. Councilperson Grover seconded. M/C Unanimous.

Councilperson London moved to approve the bills and fund transfers as presented. Councilperson Grover seconded. M/C Unanimous.

Presented contract for a certified backup water and wastewater operator with Idaho Rural Water. Councilperson Lawson moved to approve the 2 contracts (1 for water and 1 for waster water) at a cost of \$450 per month. Councilperson London seconded. M/C Unanimous.

Mike Haight, Maint. Super., requested that the City sponsor an LHTAC Grant to update Transportations plans in our region. Should be no cost, but if there is a cost it will be shared by all the districts participating in the updates. Councilperson London moved to approve, councilperson Lawson seconded. M/C Unanimous.

Grader will arrive next week for everyone to take a look at and decide if they wish to go ahead with a purchase.

Council set a special meeting for October 22, 2020 at 6 p.m. to discuss the Wastewater Study Grant Project. Meeting will be held at community center.

Josh Eckert, Inland Cellular, presented an informal proposal to put equipment on the water tower for cell and internet service. He will get us a spec list for equipment.

Airbridge was present to present contract for Internet Service, with equipment on the water tower. Councilperson Lawson moved to approve this contract and Councilperson London seconded. M/C Unanimous.

Discussion of RV Ordinance. This will be placed on the November Agenda.

Discussion of publishing our Ordinances on the website. Annual cost is \$500. Councilperson London moved to approve and Councilperson Lawson seconded. M/C Unanimous.

Discussion regarding Community Center rents. Councilperson Lawson moved to increase rental fees to \$200 with a refundable cleaning deposit of \$500. Councilperson London seconded. M/C Unanimous.

Winchester Days Assoc. requested permission to close down Nezerce Ave. from Algoma to Lewis on October 31st to allow for a Trunk or Treat event. Councilperson Lawson moved to approve and Councilperson Grover 2nd M/C Unanimous.

No further business. Councilperson Grover moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilperson London seconded. M/C Unanimous.
