

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL

8 JULY 2021

7:00 P.M

Mayor ProTem London called meeting to order. Mayor Youngren absent. Councilperson Grover absent.

Minutes: June 3 and June 28. Councilperson Morris moved, Councilperson London seconded. M/C Unanimous.

Bills and fund transfers: Councilperson Lawson moved to approve the bills and fund transfers. Councilperson Morris seconded. M/C Unanimous.

Mike: Water Resources checked our pump production for our water rights. We should get a report back this fall.

Put RFP in the Herald on the 15th. Grant and Engineering with closing date of July 29th. Then consider at August meeting.

Library Roof – Miller \$15,000 to \$20,000. Get something in writing. Would get done this year.

Jeremy Heft, Fire Chief: All fires banned within city limits immediately.

Winchester Days and Shovel Creek Fire.

Everything will be staged in Craigmont at Highland School. Type II will be set up tomorrow morning. Updates will come thru their PIO.

Shovel Creek (15,000 acres), Captain John Creek (threat to Waha) and Deere Creek. Hoover Ridge (10,000 acres) Spike camp probably at Forest.
