Made DEQ Grant list for \$4.3 million – 100% funding. Public comment period ends June 10th. DEQ has meeting on June 23rd. Will know more after that meeting.

Seeking grant Rural Fire Capacity grant – seeking 6 wildland fire turnouts Completed wild land fire pack tests

Assist Lakeside with emergency response plans – asked for emergency services assistance. Fire permits begin June 20, 2022 thru October 20, 2022. Councilperson Morris moved to approve. Councilperson Lawson seconded. M/C Unanimous.

New vehicle and equipment grant for QRU has been submitted. \$102,000 for vehicle including lights and graphics. \$106,000 100% grant including additional items requested.

Property discussion: 305 Spalding Ave. – Moore property – remove abandoned vehicles from the right of way. Had the vehicle tagged for removal. City would need to pay for the property to be towed? City would not be liable for the tow costs and storage fees. Tell the Sheriff to get the vehicle removed. Councilperson moved to have vehicle towed and to tag and remove the second vehicle also.
