## OPEN BURNING PERMIT

The burning permit is required by Idaho Code 38-115: rules are in IDAPA 20.04.01.060. In all cases equipment and personnel capable of controlling the fire must be on site. At no time shall any fire be set when the wind is blowing to such an extent as to cause danger of the fire getting out of control. There permit shall be subject to the following conditions:

Permits shall be required from May 10 to October 20<sup>th</sup>, (unless otherwise authorized by the City of Winchester Fire Chief). Inclusive, of each year, and be limited to that time period to cover a period of no more than ten (10) days.

This permit does not relieve permittee from responsibility of fire damage and suppression costs should the fire burn out of control without adequate and proper precautions being taken to prevent its spread per Idaho Code 28-107. This permit can be revoked or suspended at any time in the interest of public safety per Idaho Code 38-115.

The Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) open burning rules. IDAPA 58.01.01.603 prohibit open burning of plastics, garbage, tires and other rubber materials, paint, animal carcasses and animal wastes, asphalts material, treated lumber, demolition and construction debris, tradewaste, etc.

Permittee shall check on weather forecast pertinent to the permit prior to ignition and maintain a weather check until the fire is dead out.
